Seventh – Twelfth Grade Supply List

General Expectations

It is expected that all students will arrive prepared to learn on the first day of school. This means that each student will have supplies appropriate to them. Some students prefer an assortment of spiral-bound notebooks while others prefer three-ring binders and loose-leaf paper. **Unless otherwise stated below**, students are free to choose what works best for them. It is highly recommended that students have (and use!) a daily planner that will allow them a consistent and convenient means of tracking assignments. *Please see the information below for additional course-specific requirements.*

General Requirements (all students throughout the school year)

- Appropriate notebooks and/or binders for managing each course.
- Pencils, pens, colored pencils, glue stick, and highlighters.
- Lined paper.

Additional Course-Specific Requirements

AP Government (11th/12th Grades)

- One binder (3-ring) with dividers.
- 3x5 Index cards.

AP United States History (10th Grade)

- One 3-inch binder (3-ring) with 10 dividers.

Bible

- New American Standard Bible, text edition. Available in the school office. Cost: \$20.

British Literature (12th grade)

- One 2-inch binder with dividers.

Seventh Grade English / Eighth Grade English

- Three spiral-bound notebooks, minimum of 100 pages each.

Freshman English / Sophomore English / AP English Literature (12th Grade)

- One 3-inch binder (3-ring).
- Three spiral-bound notebooks.

Georgia History (8th Grade)

- One binder (3-ring) with 5 dividers.

Geometry (11th Grade)

- Ball bearing metal compass.
- Protractor.
- Ruler.
- Graph Paper (optional but very helpful).

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Mathematics (7th – 10th Grades)

- 1 to 1.5” binder with dividers.
- College-Ruled paper (optional but very helpful).
- Three plastic pocket folders (colors by grade level: 7th – Purple, 8th – Green, 9th – Red, 10th – Yellow).

Personal Fitness (9th Grade)

- Note: Personal Fitness is taught during the second semester. Students are required to change into a CCA PE uniform before class. Students will have access to a locker in the gym locker rooms.
- PE Uniform: CCA navy shorts (fingertip length), gray Ram’s t-shirt, and non-marking athletic shoes with laces.

Science (all grades)

- Scientific or graphing calculator (see “Calculator Policy” for specific calculator requirements).

Seventh Grade Art and Music Classes

- Art: Wide-ruled composition book (Mead, black, hardcover) – Label with student name.
- Music: Wide-ruled composition book (Mead, black, hardcover) – Label with student name.
- Ukulele (optional).

Spanish 1 (10th Grade) / Spanish 2 (11th Grade)

- 3x5 Index cards.

United States History (College Prep – 10th Grade)

- One 2-inch binder with dividers.

Calculator Policy

- MS Math – TI-30XS (or basic scientific calculator that includes π and $\sqrt{\quad}$ (square roots).
- HS Math – The official school calculator is the TI-84 Graphing Calculator. The “Plus” or “CE” versions are highly recommended, but not required. Other calculators, such as various Casio graphic calculators, may be used, but their functionality is not taught. Students will be responsible for learning how to perform certain functions on all non-TI-84 calculators.

Computer Lab

- Note – Due to network security, flash drives will not function on school lab computers. Students are highly encouraged to use a cloud-based account, such as OneDrive or Google, for saving and accessing computer-based assignments.
